

Dupont Rescue Experience ATV Rules

These rules are in addition to any rules provided by Dupont Forest staff members or exercise instructors.

- Stay on designated marked routes. Shortcuts are not allowed.
- Stay off trails that are closed for restoration. Avoid wet trails and wheel spins.
- Spark arresters, mufflers and brakes are required for motorized vehicles.
- Keep noise levels low.
- Don't harass wildlife.
- Wear your helmet and protect your eyes and face.
- Be prepared to walk out in case of a breakdown.
- Don't carry passengers on ATVs in unapproved locations or methods.
- Ride with others ---never alone.
- Many trails are dangerous to unskilled riders. Don't exceed your ability and experience.
- Slow down when sight lines are poor. Cross streams only at designated fording points, where the trail crosses the stream.
- Leave gates as you find them.
- Yield the right of way to those passing you or traveling uphill. Yield to mountain bikers, hikers, and horses.
- Proceed with caution around horses.
- No ATVs are to leave the Guion Farm Base Camp without an ICS 204 from the Incident Management Team.
- Overnight parking of ATVs is to be done in accordance with the site safety plan as posted the exercise weekend.
- Failure to follow these rules may result in demobilization from the exercise. Safety First!



STREAMS: Cross streams where the trail crosses the stream at a 90 degree angle.

CUTTING SWITCHBACKS: Switchbacks are designed to maintain the stability of a trail. Cutting them destroys their integrity.

OBSTACLES: Drive over, not around, obstacles such as small rocks and logs to avoid widening the trail.
